Our WISE semester 2020 starts on November 9, 2020 and ends on February 9, 2021. Physical presence at our institute, although welcome, is not absolutely necessary, since both our research seminars and personal contacts are offered via internet (zoom). Presentations in the seminar can be given in English, German, French, Italian or Spanish, and drafts of master's or doctoral theses to be submitted to other universities, or essays and book manuscripts intended for publication, can be discussed and commented in these languages. (If possible, oral presentations outside of personal contacts should be given in English to enable all participants in the research seminars or webinars to participate in the discussions in a lively and active way). *The application period for WISE 2020 ends on November 7. We respond to every application within 24 hours.*

The DHIP is a pure research and teaching institute that does not award any academic degrees of its own. Normally, a researcher or student at the DHIP will be a professor, researcher, doctoral candidate or post-doctoral student at a university. The characteristics and special features of studying at the DHIP described on our homepage explain that it is a useful addition to the studies and research done at different Universities, during a study break, after, or parallel to university studies or research at other universities.
